Developing and adopting regulations to implement various provisions of the *Charter Schools Act of 1992* (Part 26.8 of the *Education Code*, commencing with Section 47600).

Approving or denying requests to waive otherwise applicable provisions of law based upon requests submitted by charter schools and other local education agencies.

Assigning numbers to charter school petitions to ensure that the statutory cap on the number of charter schools is not exceeded.
